### Search and Rescue (SAR)

"Good news.....bad news". The good news is there have been no official "call outs" for SAR since our support to Grant County last November. Apparently, even the dementia and individuals autistic had enough of their facilities to stay out of the weather this winter. Plus, with improved cellular service around Mount Spokane, potentially lost individuals are able to use GPS apps or talk their way back to the parking lot. The bad news is there have been no official "call outs". While this sounds somewhat perverse, SAR team members go to great personal effort in time and expense to maintain proficiency skills in First Aid, GPS tracking, search protocols, land navigation, etc., and the list goes on. To be willing to commit to all of that, there has to be an underlying desire to rise up

to the challenge and demonstrate those skills to help others. When the need occurs, we currently have sixteen (16) members which includes two new younger) add-on's, (and namely JoAnn Post, a Snow Show recruit, and Cody Christensen, a recent County SAR Academy graduate. Α hearty welcome to both into Winter Knights SAR.

As previously mentioned, training has been continuous and most recently with participation in the Spokane County Mock Exercise conducted Saturday, March 26th at Fishtrap Recreational Area outside Sprague. It started out with a hasty ATV search for three individuals "scouting for turkey hunting areas", but was cut short approximately 5 miles later when Bob's Razor developed a grinding noise in the rear axle. Our

involvement then shifted from search to recovery. This has not been a good winter for Bob's toys! First, he had problems with his snowmobile after the Priest Lake ride (tether switch). Then it was his diesel truck acting up coming back from McCall, ID. Thought it was fixed after a tune-up maintenance session. however, the problem returned....only worse, which forced him to creep into Island Park. Eight (8) injectors later, Bob now has the feel of a new engine fully capable to trailer his Razor to the repair shop. Sorry Bob, but I needed something to say for the newsletter.

#### **Ride Definitions**

**TRAIL RIDE:** Trail Rides will accommodate riders of all skill levels. The ride will stay on groomed trails and cover 40 to 70+ miles.

**TRAIL** / **OFF TRAIL:** These rides will accommodate riders of all skill levels. These rides will use the groomed trail system and stop at play areas, like meadows & clear cuts, for riders in the group that would like to test their off trail skills. Off trail skills instruction will be available for anyone interested in improving there off trail abilities.

**MOUNTAIN RIDE:** These rides are for riders with intermediate or advanced off trail skills. Groomed trails will be used to access open mountain faces & large steep clear cut areas. Beacon, Probe, Shovel and basic avalanche training are mandatory. Skills clinic will be available at these rides.

**BACK COUNTRY RIDE:** Expert level mountain riding skills are required for these rides. Avalanche rescue gear and avalanche training are mandatory. Expect tree riding on steep slops, big climbs with some vertical lips, deep snow, water crossings and long days.
